Annual Meeting in Review – A review of another remarkable year was heard. December 28 marks the Park's 20th birthday! There was discussion of how we celebrate.

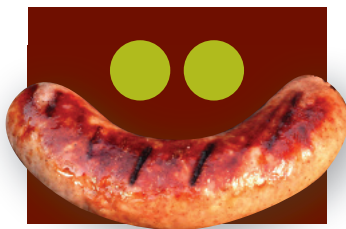
